# Personal Counseling for ALL Students

School Counselors are available to assist students with a wide range of personal concerns including such areas as social, family, emotional, mental heath, or substance abuse. A student may request to visit the school counselor's office and parents may request resources from a counselor.

A student who wishes to meet with a school counselor about personal concerns should request to visit the school counselor's office by filling out an online form on the Student Support Counselor page or the CSHS Counselor Corner page in itsLearning.

If a parent is concerned about their child's mental or emotional health, please call the CSHS Counseling Office at 281-284-1341 and ask to speak with a school counselor for a list of resources that may be of assistance.

Student Support Groups — In order to meet the personal needs of students, school counselors may also offer support groups on a recurring basis. The support groups meet during the school day for approximately 45 minutes per week. The class time in which groups meet rotates so students do not miss any class more than once every nine weeks. These groups are intended to provide a safe, confidential, and supportive setting for the students to discuss concerns and practice behaviors that will support growth and development.

If a parent/guardian does not want their student to participate in a support group, written documentation of denial of services will need to be provided to the school counselor. **Counseling Intern** — We are excited to have Ms. Sarah Sodano support our campus as a Counseling Practicum/Intern Student. University of Houston, Clear Lake trains individuals to be school counselors and licensed professional counselors. As part of this training, counselor practicum students work to support the Texas Comprehensive Counseling Program at our campus. If Ms. Sodano is going to work with your student on a regular basis, an additional consent from will be sent home. Ms. Sodano will be supported by Mrs. Karen Grayson, Student Support Counselor at Clear Springs High School and her professor from University of Houston, Clear Lake.

## Virtual Counseling

Virtual Counseling support may occur throughout the school year with students during a change in the CCISD COVID-19 protocol or an intermittent school to home closure. Virtual counseling supports may include: itsLearning messaging/ chat, video conferencing, guidance lessons in coordination with your student's teacher or support groups via Teams, etc. If a counselor wants to schedule a Teams meeting with a student, the counselor will first contact the parent to gain permission as well as review the limits of confidentiality.


