
Attendance

► Compulsory Attendance

► Texas Education Code Section 25.085 (Compulsory Attendance Law) requires school attendance until the student's eighteenth birthday. A person who voluntarily enrolls in or attends school after the person's 18th birthday shall attend school until the end of the school year. **A student may not be given credit for a class unless the student is in attendance for a minimum of 90 percent of the days the course is offered. Parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for their student's attendance. The parent/guardian is to contact the school when the student is absent.**

- A parent must provide an explanation for any absence upon the student's arrival or return to school. The student must submit a note signed by the parent or provide documentation (medical notes) specifying specific dates the student was out.
- Attendance is ongoing from week to week until **May 20th**.
- Student can be clear one week and have Saturday school the following week because of absences.
- Student must complete their assigned time before graduation.

Prom Information

- ▶ Where: Moody Gardens Convention Center, EXPO A
- ▶ Time: 7:30 PM - 11:30 PM
- ▶ Ticket Sales:
 - ▶ \$50 - Early Charger Special: April 4th-8th during all lunches, release periods, and after school.
 - ▶ \$70 - April 11th -22nd during lunches ONLY
 - ▶ \$80 - Last Minute tickets during lunches ONLY

PARKING INFORMATION FOR PROM

- ▶ There are 4 other proms on April 30th at Moody Gardens. It is important to be in the right place.
- ▶ Make sure if parking, you park in the garage next to the Convention Center - NOT hotel.
- ▶ Limos should pull around the RIGHT of the garage and drop off in front of the doors labeled “A”

Restrictions for Purchasing Tickets

- ▶ Must be clear of all fees and fines. Including library, textbooks, and others.
- ▶ Please check your skyward “fee management” to verify you are clear of all fines prior to purchasing your ticket. Prom tickets can not be purchased if you have a fee balance.
 - ▶ Student must bring a print of the Skyward report showing that they and their CSHS guest are clear at the time of purchase.
- ▶ If you are bringing a date to prom from another school, please make sure you have a CSHS activity permission slip completed. These forms are available on the CSHS website.
- ▶ Students must submit a signed acknowledgement of the rules and regulations at time of purchase. All seniors and their guests must have a completed form.

Rules and Regulations for Prom

- ▶ No person over the age of 20 will be admitted as a guest.
- ▶ The person you designate as your guest at the time of purchase must be the person you bring to prom. If you would like to make a change to this information, it must be addressed with Mrs. Huerta (2300/2400) prior to April 28th at noon, or your guest will not be allowed to enter the prom.
- ▶ You will not be allowed to enter prom after 10:00 PM. Please make dinner plans accordingly. You will not be allowed to enter and exit. If you leave, you may not re-enter.

Rules and Regulations for Prom

- ▶ **This is an official school function. All school rules apply.** -- Any use of alcohol, drugs, vapes, or tobacco will lead to removal from the prom and appropriate disciplinary procedures. Discipline could include an AEP assignment, in addition to any legal ramifications.
- ▶ **This applies to you AND your guest.**
- ▶ You and your date must be appropriately dressed. Anyone dressed in inappropriate attire will be asked to leave. If you are concerned about this issue, please see Mrs. LaFoy prior to the prom.

MANDATORY Graduation Practice

- ▶ All seniors are required to attend graduation practice on 5/20. Time TBD
- ▶ Please reschedule any plans for this time and arrange your college orientations to not be on this date.
- ▶ Seniors will report to competition gym.
- ▶ Students will be given their Quadrant for check in and seating location.
- ▶ Tickets will not be needed this year.
- ▶ Faculty who read the graduates' names will be checking pronunciation.

Graduation!!!!

- ▶ Sunday, May 22, 2022- 8:00 pm - Challenger Columbia Stadium
- ▶ Graduation will be livestreamed on the district website
- ▶ Seniors must report to stadium by 6:00pm
- ▶ Parking will open for Seniors and Guests at 5:30 pm
- ▶ Graduates will be thoroughly checked before they are allowed to enter the stadium this includes the use of metal detecting wands.
 - ▶ Purses, cell phones, smart watches, ipods, bags, umbrellas, or other personal items will not be allowed at the ceremony. Students should leave these items in the car, at home, or with family.
 - ▶ Any items collected at check in will be available for pick up after the ceremony behind the stage in the endzone.
- ▶ Students may not decorate their mortar board or other graduation attire. Balfour will be on-site to assist with tassels and other cap and gown concerns.

Dress Code for Graduation

- ▶ Seniors must be in the required attire. If they are not dressed correctly, they will be required to change or not participate in the ceremony.
- ▶ No jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, or flip-flops will be allowed.
- ▶ Young Men: white button up shirt, dark tie and black slacks, and dark socks. Simple jewelry is acceptable.
- ▶ Young Women: dress with simple neckline or skirt/blouse that does not extend below the gown. You may also choose to wear black slacks. Simple jewelry, is acceptable.
- ▶ Any clothing items that extend beyond the hem of the gown must be black.
- ▶ Because of the surface of the field and for the students' safety, shoes *will be flat*
- ▶ NO heels or wedges will be allowed.

Challenger Columbia Stadium

- ▶ All bags must be clear. Please remind guests, parents, and family members that large bags or backpacks are not allowed.
- ▶ Items such as balloons, large signs, or noisemakers are prohibited.
- ▶ Water will be sold by Class of 2023 Project Graduation at the stadium throughout the ceremony.
- ▶ Please make plans to meet your graduate in a specific location for pictures and celebrations.
- ▶ For after graduation plans, please include time to leave the parking lot in your preparations.
- ▶ Support for adults with disabilities - additional seating will be available/accessible on the field if preferred.

Balfour

- ▶ Cap and Gowns can still be order at balfourgrad.com.
- ▶ Balfour will deliver caps and gowns to the students during all lunches on 4/25 and 4/26.
- ▶ Students should try on the gown before leaving campus the day they pick up their gown.
- ▶ If you are still interested in ordering announcements for graduation, the deadline has passed for local orders. You will need to go to Balfour.com and the factory will ship the items to the student's home.

Ceremony Photographer

- ▶ There will be a professional photographer at the ceremony.
- ▶ A picture will be taken with Mr. Houston as you receive your diploma cover.
- ▶ A picture will also be taken after you exit the stage.
- ▶ Photo information will be available in the diploma cover you receive at the ceremony and sent to parents via the Skylert system.

Credits Out-Side the School Day

- ▶ For those students completing credits alternatively through TTUISD Credit by Correspondence/Credit By Exam, Clear Access, Clear Stars, credit must be completed and confirmed by Senior's Counselor by April 30th.
- ▶ Dual Credit will be completed on the COM schedule.
 - ▶ **IMPORTANT!**
 - ▶ Dual Credit Students: following your College of the Mainland Final Exams, order your transcript to go from COM to CSHS, and order your transcript to go from COM to the college you are attending.

Senior Survey: April 27th

- ▶ The Senior Survey is a CCISD requirement, and this is where the students will indicate where their final transcript will be sent to their college of choice, input any awarded scholarships, and if not attending college, indicate their path after graduation.
- ▶ Students will complete this survey in Naviance, and they will need to bring a charged laptop or device on Wednesday, April 27th.
- ▶ If a student is Dual Credit or absent, students need to see Mrs. Nylan.

Senior Exams (Required activity for all seniors who are not exempt)

- ▶ **Friday, May 13, 2022:** 1st Period – Final Exam during Regular 1st period
- ▶ **Monday, May 16, 2022:** 6th and 7th period - Final Exams during Regular 6th and 7th period
- ▶ **Tuesday, May 17, 2022:** 4th and 5th period - Final Exams during Regular 4th and 5th period
- ▶ **Wednesday, May 18, 2022:** 2nd and 3rd period - Final Exams during Regular 2nd and 3rd period

Final Exam Exemptions (Senior Exams start - 5/13)

1. Requirements Per Class:
 - ▶ Spring semester course average of seventy-five (75) or above, and
 - ▶ No conduct grade lower than satisfactory
 - ▶ There may be no outstanding credit appeal hours
2. To be eligible for exemption, a student may not have a discipline referral in the spring semester from the class of exemption. A discipline referral is any offense other than a tardy to class. The student must also be clear of all fines and detention halls. Students must not have served time in ISS or been suspended at home during the spring semester.
3. As a result of clear and compelling evidence of a violation of the Secondary Honor Code, a student is not eligible for any semester exam exemptions.
4. Credit Recovery courses are not eligible for semester exam exemptions.

Guidelines for AP Semester Exam Exemptions

1. Student must take the designated College Board Advanced Placement Exam for that course.
2. Spring semester course average of seventy (70) or above.
3. Student may not have a discipline referral in the spring semester from the class of exemption. A discipline referral is any offense other than a tardy to class. The student must also be clear of all fines and detention halls. Students must not have served time in ISS or been suspended at home during the spring semester.
4. As a result of clear and compelling evidence of a violation of the Secondary Honor Code, a student is not eligible for any semester exam exemptions.

Laptop Pick Up

- ▶ All seniors are required to turn in their laptops and laptop chargers.
- ▶ If students do not turn these in they will not be cleared for graduation.
- ▶ Students will turn in laptops during the last two weeks of classes for seniors.
- ▶ Please look for these items now and start preparing them to be returned.
- ▶ Fees and Fines will be impacted by damage and/or not returned laptops and materials.
